

Heaven = Enter through the Narrow Gate. There are risk factors in you, the factors that makes you sin.

Matthew 7:13-27 “Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life and only a few find it. Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognise them. Do people pick grapes from thorn bushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will recognise them. “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord, ‘will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, ‘Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?’ Then I will tell them plainly, ‘I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!’ “Therefore, everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.” Amen, Hallelujah!

Let us read Matthew Chapter 25. It is about the Talents. Let us read from verse 30.’ And throw that worthless servant outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’ “When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his glorious throne. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. He will put the sheep on his right and the goats on his left. Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty, and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, and I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.’ Then the righteous will answer him, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and cloth you? When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?’ The King will reply, ‘Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.’ Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels.’ Amen. Hallelujah!

Please repeat after me. “Heaven - Let us enter through the narrow gate!” This will be today’s message. People who believe in Jesus must be saved. Believing in Jesus is based on the premise that we can go to heaven. If you can’t go to heaven, even if you’re healed from sickness, receive the power, and have done many good works, all are in vain. We must end up in heaven no matter what. Going to heaven seems easy, yet it is difficult. When we believe in Jesus and become saved, God grants us a holy gift and ignites fire so that he can use us. When God uses you, it would be great if you carry out God’s

work to the very end with humility as you go lower and lower. But people are constantly exposed to vested interests. Of course, we need money for our daily needs. Without money, life is impoverished. It will be difficult to live. Within your means, within what your income allows, you must spend so as not to go bankrupt or fail. If you're expenses exceed your income, you will go broke.

Church members must not be deceived by their pastor. Please say, "Amen". Church members must not be deceived by the other members. Pastors must not deceive other pastors. Pastors must not deceive the worldly people. Do you understand? Pastors engaging in political campaigns is not biblical. Some of the people who followed Jesus were Zealots. These people also diligently followed Jesus for 3 & ½ years. But in the end, like Judas Iscariot, they all fell away. They were more disciples of Jesus who were Zealots. Jesus continued to speak about Israel's restoration after breaking free from the Roman yoke. But the disciples did not perceive its meaning. In the midst of it all, Jesus still repeatedly trained his disciples. You have to believe in Jesus, be saved, and go to heaven.

Pastors and congregation members believe they are saved after believing in Jesus. They are assured that they will go to heaven. They firmly believe it. After they barely passed the door of salvation. But on the way to heaven, they encounter hardships. They repeatedly encounter resistance. They may become obsessed with money. Pastors and congregation members commit adultery. They commit all types of sin behind the door. Hell is supposed to have nothing to do with us. But you may be constantly moving towards it.

The bible says that if you do the Lord's work poorly, you will go to hell. It says that if you love anything more than the Lord, you will go to hell. The bible says if you commit adultery, you will go to hell, if you keep on cussing, you will go to hell, and if you keep on getting angry, you will end up in hell. There are many elements that can send you to hell, scattered like a minefield around you. There is a minefield in the church as well. People fight, argue, and devour each other. People are in the minefield; they do not know when the landmine will explode. The minefield will also lie within a dream. Even if the person whom you believe is in heaven constantly appears in your dream, because they are already dead, it is not a good thing.

Both believers and non-believers, Satan wants to use them when they are alive, using their past because they already know their past. Especially, if you live spiritually by faith, in order to prevent you from living your life by faith, Satan will use your biggest weakness. Your biggest weakness may be your deceased mother or father, who believed in Jesus. Your biggest weakness may be your deceased relatives, husband, or wife who believed in Jesus while living. If they were saved, they are doing well in heaven. But they may constantly appear in your dreams. Humans are easily influenced by dreams and possess emotions; they think about their dreams all day long. For example, "last night I met my deceased wife (or a husband) in my dream!" The demons will make them think about dreams continuously. The demons will prevent you from doing the work of the Lord properly; instead, they will make you engrossed deeply in the dream. "Oh I'm so lonely! I used to date this person in the past..." Whether it was a good or a bad memory, the demons will make you engrossed deeply in your past. Then you must cast it out in the name of Jesus! Hallelujah! The demons work through your dreams using your past events or experiences.

When you try to live your life according to the word of God, the demons do not have many ways to attack you. Even the slightest wrong thought, the slightest anger, or the slightest argument makes prayer difficult, and I can't flow in my sermon. When we believe in Jesus, God dispatches angels to us. He sends them to us. "Protect Pastor Kim, Yong Doo well until he dies and comes into my kingdom."

The moment when we believe in Jesus and become saved, God's heavenly host will always accompany us. This is a secret of God. Hallelujah! But it won't just be heavenly host; the demons will also dispatch their hosts. The devil will also send evil spirits. "This person just got saved by believing in Jesus! He deserves hell! He angers easily, curses a lot, and when he gets mad, he becomes relentless!! Hey, the spirit of anger, go! The spirit of lewdness, go! All kinds of spirits! Go latch onto him!" These spirits may try to latch on to you, but if you have the Holy Spirit dwelling in you, they will completely detach themselves from you. They cannot stay in us if we have the Lord dwelling within us. Please say Amen. On top of it, we have guardian angels protecting us. Despite this, humans are free beings.

There is freedom in choice, thought, speech, will and emotions. If you misuse these things, Satan and evil spirits will attach themselves to you. You should be able to apply, risk, mature, and change, and you should be able to use various methods in various situations to do all types of God's work. In this process, if you do not have wisdom, knowledge, and go your own way, you will commit sin.

If you sin, what will happen? The evil spirits will latch on to you. When you commit a sin, someone else becomes complicit in your sin to the same degree that you have sinned. This is a characteristic of a sinner. If you know you're a sinner, and if you fiercely repent, you will be saved through Jesus, and all things will be well. But if you do not properly repent and delay repenting of your sins, you will walk the path of death because it is the penalty for sin. Please say "Amen." You are not going to be only one to walk the path of death. If you don't repent and come to your senses, failing to grasp the situation around you, somebody will join you in sin. Then, you will become a deceiver, and the people who sin due to your sin become deceived. It can be vice versa. Then, even if you carry out the work of the Lord, you won't be aligned with him. Please repeat, "When I sin, I will not become one with the Lord." Hallelujah! You will be in discordance with God. Even if you pray, your thoughts and heart do not align with his. What happens when a couple's hearts are not aligned? They will fight. We must go to heaven after believing in Jesus and being saved.

But the bible talks about "the narrow gate." How narrow? It's very narrow. Your thoughts, hearts, words, and will... You must properly speak, think, listen, behave, and watch the right things. The bible fiercely warns us. After being saved, if you do nothing, what will happen? It will be difficult to go to heaven. The moment you believe in Jesus, you should be able to see the things you can do for the Lord. If you properly believe, you will naturally know things that you should do for the Lord. If you possess proper belief and if you are heaven bound, you will naturally know what to do for the Lord. The task for the Lord are clearly visible. If it is not clear, you should be praying. Even if it wasn't clear, the more you pray, the more you will eventually see the spiritual and physical tasks you should do, one at a time. In other words, talents will be created.

But if you say, “I can’t do it,” it constitutes dereliction of duty. “My personality does not fit, so I can’t do this!” “I am passive, this is for the aggressive people!” “This task is for the born-again Christians!” No! The moment you believe in Jesus, your emotions, your style, your blood types, and your instincts are not your master, but the Lord becomes your master. You should be in a state where you can do all things in all situations. You may not have much experience, but you should be able to say, “I will do it.” This is the state you should become. You may not be good at it, but you should try it.

After believing in Jesus and being saved, you are supposed to go to heaven. As a saved person, you should eat spiritual food through reading the bible. You must spiritually breath through praying. Amen. What else do you need? You need to receive the Holy Spirit. The moment you believe in Jesus, the Holy Spirit enters you. Although the Holy Spirit may have entered you, and unless you desire, he will stay very quiet, like He isn’t there. The Holy Spirit will stay very quiet as though he isn’t breathing. You won’t even know if He is in you or not. He will be silent for the rest of your life. He dwells in your spirit.

To become aware of his presence in your spirit, you need to live spiritually. If you live spiritually, you will be aware of the Holy Spirit in your spirit. If you don’t live spiritually and by the spiritual way, but live by the physical way, even if you are saved the Holy Spirit won’t move. Therefore, the Holy Spirit in you deeply groans. He deeply groans. If you are still dull, He will call you, “My Child...” Then silence again. After a while, He will call you, “My son...” The Holy Spirit is keen, sensitive and delicate.

Do you know He easily becomes offended? He feels aggrieved even over small matters. ‘I see that you do not depend on me. I see that you do not believe in Me. Why are such words coming out of your mouth?’ ‘Change, growing, and maturing are possible for you, my child, my son, and daughter!’ ‘I have a particular plan and blessing for you! But how do you not know!’

I thought people need to be changed first before God uses them. But that was not the case. It is not necessary for the person to change, but the faith needs to be changed first before God uses them. Hallelujah! Once you possess extraordinary faith, you will change into an extraordinary person.

Your environment, your body, your knowledge and everything else may be inferior, but for these inferior areas to be used by God. When you face trials, hardships, and difficulties, you have to repent, hold your ground, endure, and become broken. Then you draw nearer to becoming the person of faith God desires. Hallelujah! This becomes highly influential to your faith; inspiration begins to come to you, and you will live spiritually. Hallelujah!

After believing in Jesus, you are saved. But afterwards, you are entering a minefield. Thought you may be old, the Lord still desires you to possess passion. There is still much work to be done before the Lord. You may be sick, tired, and exhausted, but the Lord still has expectations from you. Hallelujah.

In the book of Matthew, Chapter 25, servants received big amount of talents. One received 7 million dollars; the other two servants received 30 million and 100 million dollars each. If you receive a small amount of money, you will feel less pressured. But they received a huge amount; therefore, they felt very pressured. They receive too much money! The master said, “Make sure to leave a lot of profit by the time I arrive, and do good business.” Later, the owner returned and revealed all his feelings. The master revealed his heart, even His hidden feelings, to the servant who had received one talent, why

did the master rebuke him? One day, the master entrusted the servant with a great wealth. The servant was entrusted with the Master's possession. But he had no experience; therefore, he got scared.

If you have too much fear, you can't do business. Same thing with running a ministry. The one talent servant did not want to start anything with the talent that was given to him. He is like this in all areas of his life. He is selfish. He lives centered around himself. His behaviour is soulish and fleshly. He does not want to suffer a loss. The servants with five and two talents used the money entrusted to them by their Master to expand the Master's influence. "The Master gave me talents so that he might accomplish these things through me. He also gave me health and made the environment for me to work." The servant who received one talent just kept watching the servants with five and two talents as they accomplished the tasks. 'Why go out of their way to do that? Why do they live complicatedly?' The servant with one talent just kept watching. He buried one talent in the ground. 'I will not participate in all that hard work.' These types of people will never go to heaven.

When you stand before the throne of God, do you know what kind of judgement you will face? Believing or not believing is the first type of judgment before the throne of God. The next judgement is for the believers in Jesus. This is a spiritual reality. Such judgements take place on the right side of God's throne, the throne of Jesus. This is a frightening thing. Although the bible does not precisely tell us another judgement takes place on the right side of God's throne, the throne of Jesus, it talks about the judgment of the separation of the sheep and the goats before the throne of the Lamb." God's people and all the people of the worlds receive judgement. "YOU GO RIGHT, AND YOU GO LEFT! YOU ARE SHEEP, AND YOU ARE GOAT!" Some people may look like a sheep but are a goat. It is because they lived like a goat.

Jesus will say, you did not look after me when I was hungry, thirsty, sick, and when I was a stranger and in prison. You did not bother to converse with me. Therefore, you are not a sheep but a goat!" "You failed to fulfil your mission. You go to the left side. All of you go to the left side! Left side! Left, left, left side!" What does God say about those on the left? "You who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels!" This is a frightening thing! In a way, it seems like a double judgement. First, they will be judged before the throne of God. And then transferred to the throne of the Lamb to be judged, where they undergo the judgment of the sheep and goat, and actions. Later on, they will receive the white throne judgment. The white throne judgement comes after the return of Jesus and the 1000-year reign.

What could be the cause? There are risk factors in you. There are factors that make you sin. The book of 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 states ten sins. Lists of the people who will not inherit the Kingdom of God. Neither the deceivers nor the deceived will go to heaven. Do not deceive each other period. Secondly, the sexually immoral will not go to heaven. If you are married, hold the marriage bed in high esteem.

Whether your husband believes or not, you made a wedding vow before God. "In sickness and in health, for richer or for poorer..." You vowed. Do not ever forget your vow. Until death do a wife and a husband part...Until death do you part...You have to cherish the marriage bed in high esteem.

Hallelujah. Divorce has become far too common these days. The marriage bed has been defiled. It is filled to the brim with obscenity. Therefore, they cannot go to heaven.

The bible talks about principles and about rules. The statements in Matthew 7 talk about principles and about building a church on the Rock. When you hear God's word and act upon it properly, you enter heaven.

Entering through the narrow gate means doing it properly, and the path will become narrower as you live rightly. You may have lived comprehensively, objectively, and by the standards of the world. You may have lived according to general ethics and general morality. Going to heaven is very difficult. It is a narrow gate and a narrow way. Do you understand?

Idolaters. After believing in Jesus, put all your idols down. Worshipping ancestors or believing in other religions is not the only form of idolatry. You can worship yourself as your idol, putting yourself above the Lord. If your youth, thoughts, heart, and everything about you is too important, it's idolatry. You do not repent of your stubbornness because your pride is your idol. Because of your impatience, everyone must listen to you, do as you say, and you must control all your family members because you are your own idol. There's no yielding, no compromise, no consideration – you just do according to your temper.

Adulterers. People who browse. Going online browse and looking at all kinds of nonsense, and watching pornography. You will not go to heaven. You have to fiercely repent of these sins. Hallelujah! Men who have sex with men, and all homosexuals. They can never go to heaven. At birth, God gave us a gender as either male or female.

Thieves. People who steal others' belongings. They can never go to heaven. These days, many pastors commit all sorts of wicked and evil deeds. they cannot go to heaven. Not only can thieves not go to heaven. But even within the church, if you steal from fellow workers, from church members, or even from unbelievers, you won't go to heaven. I would say that over 80% of YouTube videos are all fake.

Drunkards cannot go to heaven. Always in a state of drunkenness.

Slanderers. The sin we most often fall into is cursing when we get angry. Filthy and harsh words may come out of your mouth. Parents and children shouldn't curse at each other; it causes more hurt. Please repeat after me, "If I slander and curse, I can never go to heaven." Swindlers. Needless to say, it's a terrible thing to do.

Coveting what belongs to others. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 lists ten sins. If you read 1 Corinthians 10:6-11, the content about people who can't go to heaven is coming up again. What are the reasons? "These things occur as examples."

After the Israelites had exodus, in the wilderness, "Some of them." Some of them, some of them...These "Some of them" were destined to enter the Promised Land, the land of Canaan. They were supposed to go to heaven, but they failed in their daily life, in reality.

Even if you are "destined", do not live arrogantly or recklessly because you believe you're saved. "We believe in Jesus, and we are saved! We are destined to go to heaven! Hallelujah! Amen!" Were all

those people destined to enter the land of Canaan after leaving Egypt? Or were they not? They were destined to enter! Yes, they were destined! Amen! Although they were destined, they kept failing throughout the process. They kept encountering events that failed them. Their faith had hit the limitation. They were not ready to enter the land of Canaan at all. They followed Moses, but they faced tests in the process. In the process of following Moses, suddenly, some people become categorised as "Some people.." Being categorised as some people is a very scary thing. Please repeat after me. "I must be careful not to become a 'Some people'" Once you are expressed as "Some people" you are dead.

"Some people..." Who are they? They are people who died because of idol worship, and some people died because of committing adultery. Common sense tells you, how can you commit adultery in the desert while the pillar of cloud and fire is in the midst of you? But they commit sin boldly. Sin makes people bold. Sin will make you unable to distinguish between right and wrong. "You are like that, too? Me too! After all, we are merely humans! We need to understand each other, love, and be considerate! No one is perfect: who doesn't have flaws? Everyone is like that!"

But the Lord will say to you, "You are not God's chosen people. Although you were destined to enter the land of Canaan, you can't enter. You are categorised as 'Some people!' You are a goat! You are not a people of God!" If you fail to keep your faith, you are not a people of God! If you do not pray, you are not a people of God! Please remember. You might feel like I am nagging. But if you do not come to church for God, you are not a people of God! When you don't come to church, your conscience is supposed to be convicted! You need to come to church and listen to the word of God! Amen!

If your children resist coming to church, you must rebuke them firmly. "You are a child of God! You need to come to God's temple and listen to the word of God! You must pray with the church! You must listen to the sermon together! You must be filled with the Holy Spirit!"

Rather than looking at their cell phone and watching YouTube, they need to read the bible more. Because they are a people of God. If you continue watching YouTube videos, you will be deceived. One example would be the last day's videos. People speculate about things to come. Some of the last days' videos will tell you how to prepare food, direct you where to hide, such as in a mountain. People of God will not be deceived by such statements because you will discern and interpret with the word of God. As long as you hold onto the word of God, you will not be deceived. If you get fooled by what you see and hear, you'll end up looking like a complete fool later. You will end up humiliated and unable to manage the situation. When you can still manage, you should stop. Amen! Get rid of your sloppy salvation view.

You say you are destined to be saved. Let's say there are nameplates on the destined people's houses in heaven. But what if the "destined" people fail to come to heaven? What will happen? The sadness of the Lord will begin. The houses will vanish! It is because the people who were supposed to come to heaven did not make it. They were categorised as "Some people".

You may start as a wheat by faith, but if you fail to endure the threshing of God, you will end up categorised as "Some people". "I DO NOT KNOW YOU!" This is what Matthew 7 talks about. "Lord! I cast out demons!" "I DO NOT KNOW YOU!" "Didn't I prophesy?" "I DO NOT KNOW YOU!" Cast out

demons as you precisely follow the Word of the Lord in your life! If you want to do a role of a prophet, do it properly! Fulfil your duties as a church member properly, and you must fulfil your duties as a pastor fulfil properly as well! Hallelujah! Whatever role you have, do it properly and well! Do not pretend you are doing it; do it properly.

If the Lord categorised you as “Some people” you are in big trouble. Some people were idol worshippers, adulterers, and tested the Lord. Some people resented the Lord. Our daily life is like a minefield. People grumble, complain, and do other nonsense even in the church. When it comes to living a life of faith, know that there is minefield within our church. Of course, the world is full of landmines. Outside the church, there are atom bombs, time bombs, hydrogen bombs, grenades, and all different types of them scattered. Although landmines are also in the church, it is still better than the world.

Some people died testing God. Some people died while committing adultery. In today’s time, even if you test God, commit adultery, worship idols, grumble, complain, come against a servant of God (Moses), but we have chances to repent. But in the wilderness, they had no chance to repent. They were given a brief moment to repent. Moses made a bronze snake and attached it to a pole. Those who looked at it got healed. But still, some people refused to look. Fire snakes flew over and bit them. Fire snakes appeared and bit the people who tested God, grumbled, and complained against Moses. They died from poison, swelling up after the poison spread. Although the Israelites were destined to be blessed and promised to obtain the land of Canaan, after the ten spies reported on the land, what happened? They misspoke. They had a wrong perception of what they saw. They may have spied with faith, but when they spoke, they negatively expressed, they were cursed and died. This is frightening. They had faith, and they heard accurately! But because their emotions were misplaced, they incorrectly expressed them, and they died. Therefore, your emotions, perceptions, words you speak, and how you hear must be touched by God and His grace. Please say ”Lord, may my tongue be touched by You and Your grace.” Proverbs says, “Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.” Your entire being, your personality, must be touched by God, and your entire household must be touched by God. Amen. Your children must be touched by God and His grace.

I will speak more about the narrow gate and the narrow way once again. Let us read Galatians 5:16. We will wrap it up after reading it. The more we read, the more tense we become. It is very frightening. Galatians 5:16, So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so you are not to do whatever you want. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity, and debauchery, idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions, and envy; drunkenness, orgies and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. Hallelujah. 16 lists of sins are written. We can infer there are addition sins because the statement says, “and the like.” It means there are still many mores sins similar to the 16 sins. This is why it is more frightening.

In the future, we will face God's judgement. After the judgement, we will stand on the right side of God's throne, before the throne of the Lamb. We will be judged again. "You go right. You go left. You are wheat, and you are chaff. You are sheep, and you are a goat." after one judgement, you will go through another judgement. Through the judgement of the Lamb, people will be sorted out. Finally, after Jesus returns, all people - those who drowned in the sea, those who died in accidents, and everyone else - will be resurrected from the dead. Then the White throne judgement will occur.

Although you were born with empty hands. You've received many things from the Lord. Throughout your life, you were given the opportunity to believe in Jesus and the opportunity to dedicate yourself to Him. Whether you had money or not, were healthy or not, had a foul temper or not, you will all be judged on everything before God.

There are risk factors in you, the factors that make you sin. You must pass through the minefield safely, and if you fall or stumble, get up immediately and repent quickly before God. Then continue praying. The Lord continues to guide us in every way so that we may come to heaven.

Regarding the talents, the Lord motivates us in relation to money. Because everyone likes money. There are many times when God lets us taste a certain amount of money. Then God watches how we handle, think, and feel about it. God also tests us with a lot and sees how we feel about it. "Wow! Wow! Wow!" God is trying to induce a certain motivation. Because you do not have that kind of money, you can easily say, "Even if I receive a lot of money, I will still trust and hang on to You, Lord." but once you receive thousands and millions of dollars, your true nature will be revealed. Your feelings regarding money and your true nature will be exposed. Although you said you were going to be generous, once you receive the money, you will likely say, "Oh, I have a lot of things to spend on. I am sorry, I can't give." everyone will act differently because everyone has a different level of loyalty and faithfulness.

Some people may have a strong will but not be inspired by their emotions. Some people may think about it, but have weak will and lack emotions. Some people swiftly obey without thinking. They don't usually know what to do on their own. Not all servants are the same. When the master returned, He discovered the true nature of His servants. The core question is: "Am I in alignment with the Lord's thoughts, heart, and will? Or am I out of alignment?" Things will be determined depending on how you think, act, and where your hearts is. I bless you in the name of the Lord that you choose to align yourself with the Lord today. Hallelujah!

You may have to go through continued hardship, and walk through fields of minefields. You must enter through the narrow gate, and walk the narrow way. King Solomon had wisdom. He fervently prayed. King Solomon wrote the Book of Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Songs, Psalms, and write worship songs, and so on, with God's wisdom and knowledge. But in the end, what happened? In his later years, King Solomon became a subject of ridicule among the surrounding nations and people. He became a laughingstock. King Solomon had fallen that low.

When King Solomon wrote Ecclesiastes in his old age, he wrote about folly. "Vanity of vanities, vanity of vanities! All is meaningless." For us, it does not have to be that way; it is not meaningless! God created events through which blessings could be received, yet after receiving those blessings, many

people fell into corruption. We all have weaknesses, when your weaknesses are exposed, come humbly before God, repent properly, and surrender everything. I bless you and pray that you humble yourselves before God. Hallelujah! Don't say, "I still haven't gotten any prayer answer, and don't say, "I still have nothing." Because we have the Lord! We still have many things to do!

Tonight, receive the greater power of the Holy Spirit and be greatly blessed. In the name of the Lord, I pray this blessing upon you. Let us pray. "God, thank you for Your grace. Even if we are inferior in every way, lacking possessions and deficient, nevertheless, You still have expectations for us. You induce motivation, and You have given us the faith to do all things. Father God, you want us to be faithful to the point off death. Grant us grace to pass safely through the minefield. May we not live according to the desires of the flesh, but by the power of the Holy Spirit in the freedom of the Spirit, guided by the Holy Spirit. Please work through precious grace and faith today. Fill us to overflowing with God's powerful anointing. In Jesus name we pray, Amen.
